NCPHP saved my life. There is no doubt in my mind this is true. Twenty-eight years ago, I was held prisoner by my addiction to alcohol. My craving for alcohol and compulsion to drink was controlling every facet of my life. I had long since given up on the notion that I wasn't an alcoholic. I knew I was. Every day I would get up and swear to God, to myself, and to everyone and everything I held dear I wasn't going to drink that day, but every day by three or four o'clock in the afternoon I would be drinking. It was baffling. I knew if I wanted to live and enjoy a career in medicine something was going to have to change, but going it alone wasn't working. It didn't provide me with the support and accountability I desperately needed.

That is precisely what I received from NCPHP—expert, compassionate, comprehensive guidance with built-in support and accountability. They saw to it I received the care I needed.

I went to treatment for alcoholism and have remained sober ever since. A near continuous series of losses in my life reversed and gave way to a near continuous series of gains. My life has unfolded in the most unexpected, profoundly positive and meaningful ways. I've been able to impact the lives of thousands of patients and healthcare providers alike.
